

1st Annual Klimek Bros Well Drilling 9 Pin No-Tap Tournament Rules

1. ALL BOWLERS MUST HAVE A CURRENT USBC MEMBERSHIP

Those without can purchase an associate membership prior to bowling. Bowlers may be required to show proof of membership and/or photo id. USBC rule 13 in regard to student participation will be followed.

2. HANDICAP & AVERAGES

Handicap will be based on 70% of 230 scratch.

Bowlers will use their highest sanctioned average (minimum 21 games) from the '24-'25 season.

A current league standing sheet with bowler name and average will be required for verification.

Any bowler whose highest average at the time of bowling is 10 or more pins higher, minimum 21 games, than the highest average from the previous season MUST report average before bowling.

All other bowlers will bowl scratch.

U.S.B.C. rules 319c and 319e will be strictly adhered to. Reporting MUST be done prior to bowling. Failure to comply will result in disqualification.

Sport and Challenge adjustment charts will be used when necessary.

Tournament management reserves the right to adjust the entering average of ANY bowler.

Falsification of averages will result in disqualification.

3. REPORTING

Any bowler who has either won or is in position to win \$600 or more in one event or tournament within the previous 12 months at time of bowling must report winnings to tournament management along with the actual score bowled, position, and the amount of the prize.

Tournament management may request all tournament scores bowled from the previous 12 months at time of bowling from any tournament participant.

Bowlers are required to report any average adjustments from other tournaments or associations, USBC rule 319c.

Any bowler who places in the top 5 (five) of any event or is in line to win a prize of \$600 or more will receive an Average Verification form. Form must be properly and completely filled out and returned to Garden Center within the designated time given. Failure to meet any of these requirements will result in disqualification.

4. PARTICIPATION & SIDE EVENTS

Doubles can be entered an unlimited number of times, both people must bowl the same shift. Bowlers may enter doubles with the same partner multiple times, but can only cash in the top 10 once.

Senior Singles can be entered once per shift and bowlers must be at least 55 years of age as of the first day of competition. Entrants may be asked to prove age. Bowlers can only cash in the top 10 once.

5. MISC ITEMS

Each individual bowler is responsible for the accuracy of the information provided, his/her teammates and captain are also liable for this information.

Tournament management reserves the right to accept or reject any entry.

Tournament management reserves the right to move bowlers in the event of a mechanical failure.

All decisions by the Tournament Management regarding prizes will be considered final as published. No legal action for prize money may be brought after one year from the date that prize checks are issued.

Premature termination of the tournament brought about by war, national emergency or natural causes relating thereto or therefrom, fire, natural disaster or any other reason beyond the control of Garden Center Lanes shall cause, to the extent required hereby, all advertised prizes, guaranteed or otherwise, to be pro-rated in accordance with the number of entrants who have bowled in each of the respective events up to the time of such termination.
